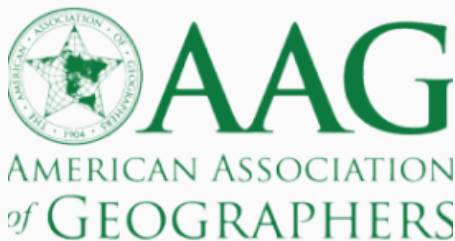

## 2 Common Strategies for Creating a Hybrid Experience



This guide will help event planners that will be planning their in-person event as usual, and expect most speakers and staff to be in-person.

Under these circumstances most event planners will end up offering virtual attendees one of the two options:

### 1 A LIVE BROADCAST WITH VIRTUAL PARTICIPATION

**Option A:** All Speakers / presenters are in-person and content should be live-streamed to the virtual audience.

**Option B:** Most speakers / presenters are in-person, 1 or 2 speakers are joining remotely, all content live streamed.

---

### 2 RECORDED IN-PERSON AND REPLAYED FOR VIRTUAL

**Option A:** All speakers / presenters are in-person and sessions are replayed virtually. Speakers rejoin the virtual conference for Q&A during their recordings.

**Option B:** Virtual attendees watch later at scheduled time for on-demand viewing.

## How to Setup a Live Hybrid Experience with Virtual Participation

### THE EXPERIENCE FOR VIRTUAL ATTENDEES



Virtual attendees view session slides, along with the conference camera feed and audio feed from Zoom. Virtual attendees can ask in-person speakers questions through an in-person volunteer who monitors Zoom Q&A and announces questions at the in-person event.

### THE EXPERIENCE FOR IN-PERSON



In-person attendees have a typical conference experience, and watch any remote presentations (from Zoom) through the event projector and speakers.

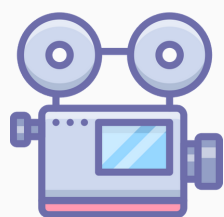

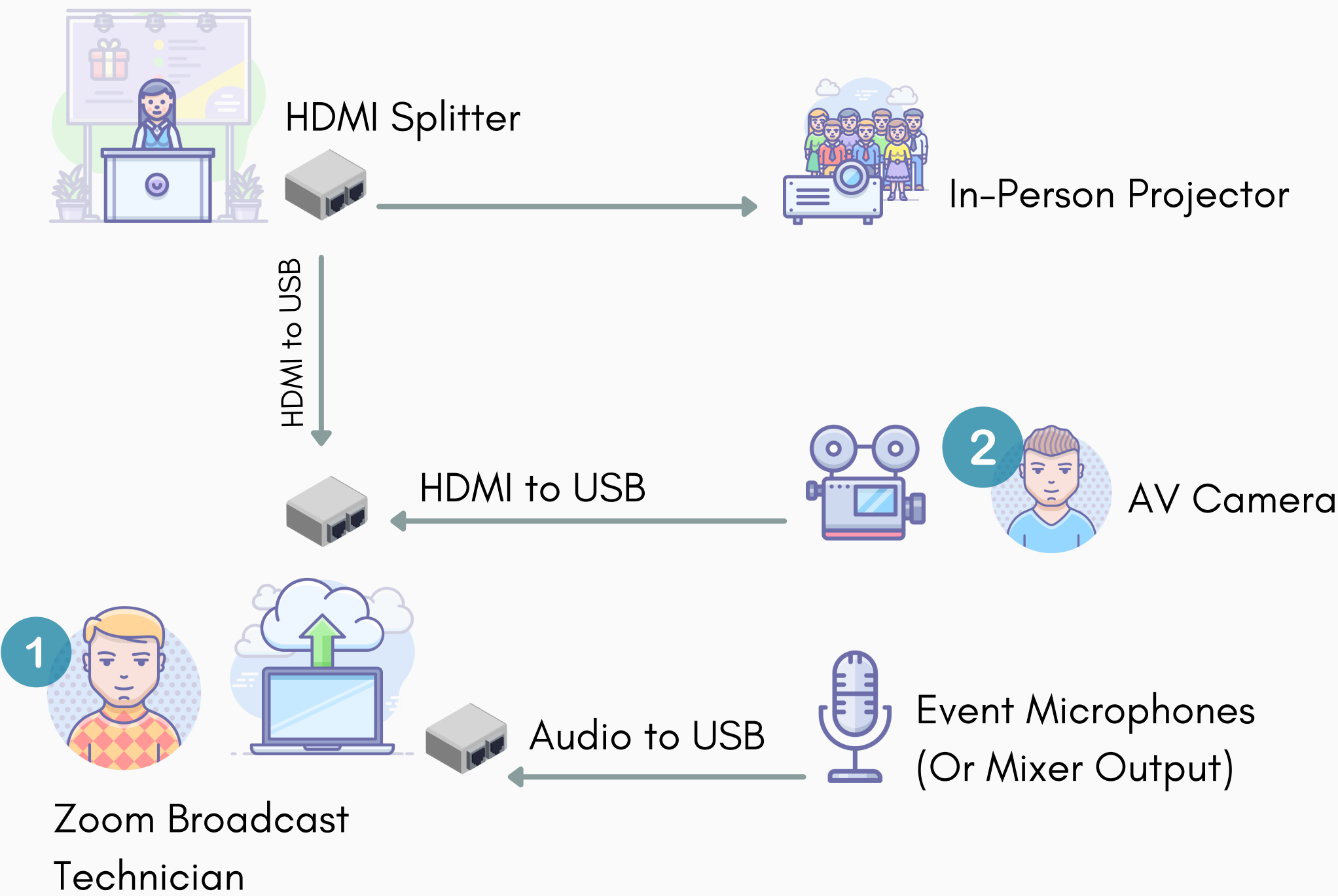

# How to Configure a Live Zoom Broadcast with Virtual Participation

## In-Person AV Team

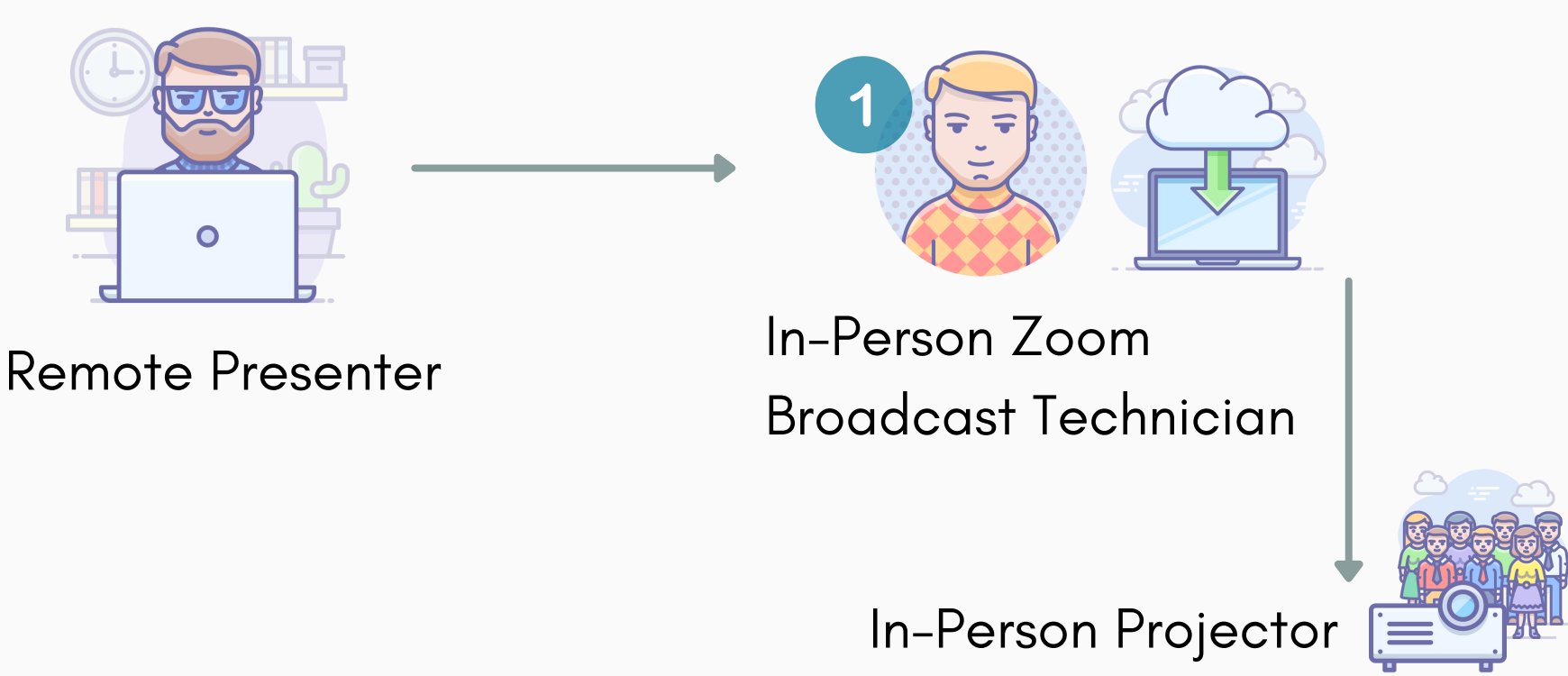

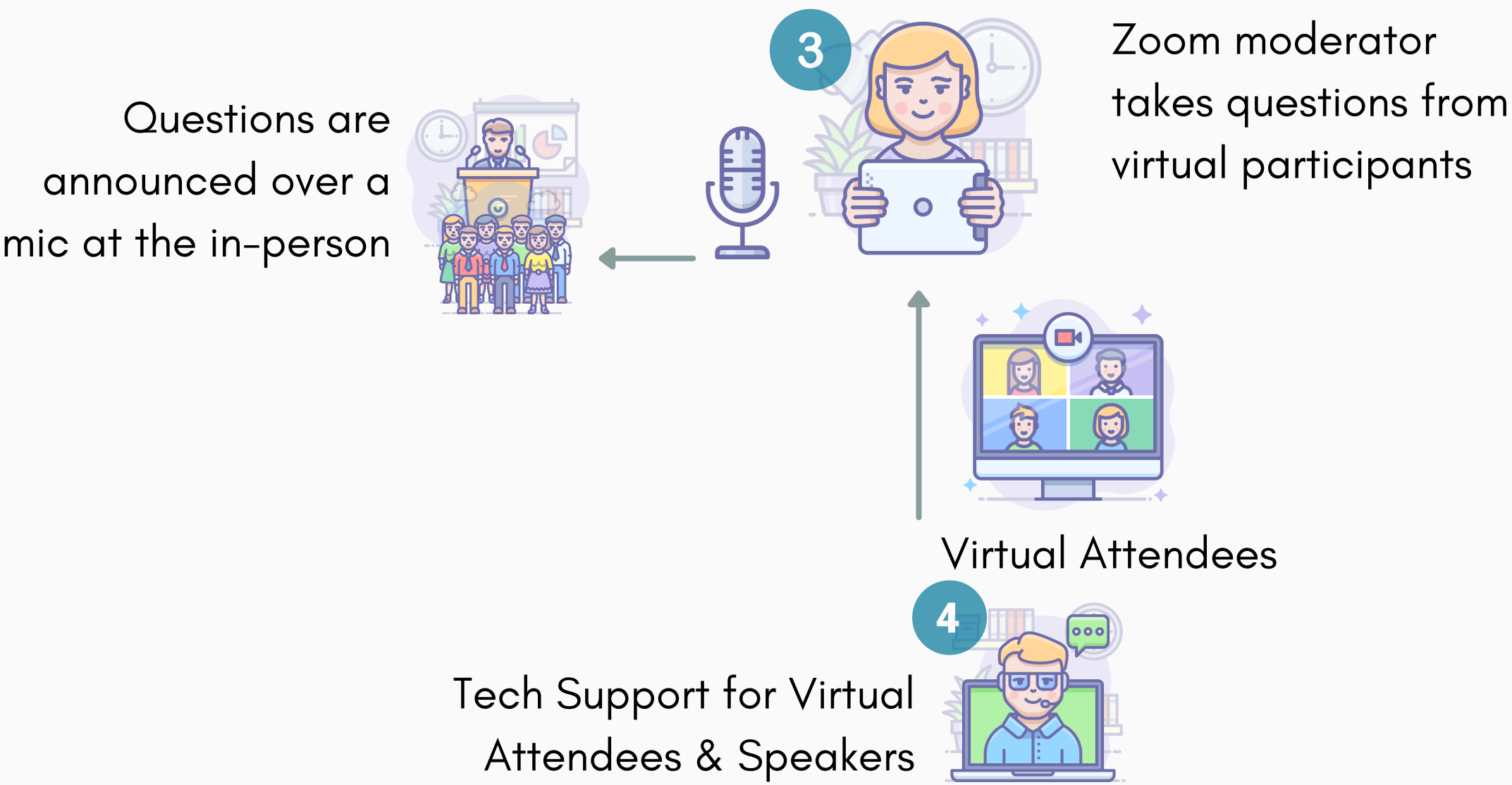
# How to Configure Remote Presenters and Virtual Q&A

## Remote Presenters

The remote speaker presents through Zoom to both the live and virtual audience. The Zoom broadcast technician sends this to the in-person projector and speakers.

# How to Record an In-Person Event and Replay Sessions for a Virtual Event

## THE EXPERIENCE FOR VIRTUAL



Virtual attendees can view the replays on-demand. In order to create virtual engagement with speakers, speakers can be brought back to the virtual event to answer questions in chat while their sessions are replayed.

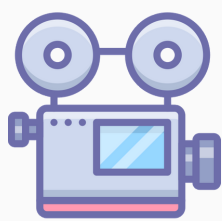
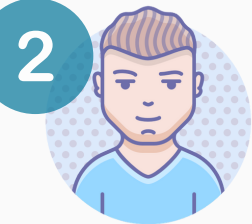
